B TECH PRESTIGIOUS SCHOLARSHIP (DEAN'S LIST) 2019

Criteria for B Tech Scholarship

- a) An aggregate of **70%** for the exit level subjects of the National Diploma.
- b) To support the aim of the initiative only students that **will register for a B Tech programme that will lead to an approved PQM on master's degree level** will be eligible for the award.
- c) Students should be **South African citizens**.
- d) Students should register for **full-time B Tech studies**
- e) The following criteria can be used as a guideline in the selection process:
 - 1) Students must have **completed their National Diploma in three (continuous) years**.
 - 2) Students must have **clear academic standing** and should be void of disciplinary action within the period of study at TUT.
 - 3) Students must **not have failed any (major) subject** during the period of study.
 - 4) Students must have **demonstrated the ability to work independently on projects**.
- f) The funding can be used towards tuition fees, accommodation and books. This is in line with the prestigious scholarships offered by NRF on B Tech level. Academic Departments can top-up the award from other sources and faculties must ensure that students apply for external funding.
- g) Students who **receive any other scholarship** more the TUT scholarships (e.g. NRF, MRC, Mandela-Rhodes, TUT-CSIR, etc.) will not be eligible for a B Tech prestige Scholarship,
- h) Eligible students will be expected to sign an agreement.
- i) Students that register in the 2nd semester qualify for an half a scholarship; these students qualify for an half a scholarship in 2018, base on submission of Proof of Registration.
- j) Students **must intend to register for Master's degree after completing B Tech studies**.
